We will have a **TEST** at the end of each unit consisting of cumulative short answer & multiple choice questions. Completion of your review sheet will help you be successful on test day. There will be at least one **QUIZ** per unit taken in class as well as a take-home, review quiz using IXL.com.

Students who **MISS** a test or quiz will be expected to make it up during class when they return.

FINAL EXAM



Math 3 will have an NC End of Course (EOC) exam in January. The exam will consist of around 60 calculator active multiple choice, gridded response, and technology assisted questions.

REMEDICATION & TEST SCORE IMPROVEMENT

If you miss questions on a test, you will have the opportunity to correct the test during class, SMART Lunch or at home to relearn the material. I will help you with anything you do not understand. Completing test corrections for all missed problems on Test 1 prior to taking Test 2 will unlock the chance to earn a higher grade on Test 1. Test 2 will contain questions from Test 1. If you do better on Test 2 than you did on Test 1 AND you turned in Test 1 Corrections, the average of Test 1 and Test 2 scores will replace your Test 1 grade. The same plan will be used for each test this semester.

This year, you will complete a 30 minute assignment for homework. I will check your completed work at the beginning of class. Late work will be accepted for half credit. You must make up homework missed when absent.

CLASSWORK



During class we will recall old and discover new skills. While working together we will get the practice necessary to use the skills in more challenging problems. Make up work will be given to you when you return from absences to be completed prior to the end of the unit.
